Online Registration through PS

- Grade 11
 - Must pick an ELA, SS, Math and a Science
 - Must pick CALM
 - Must continue with 2 options or pick an INTRO class
 - Must have 7 + CALM
 - 38 credits in total

Online Registration –PS

- Grade 12
 - Must register in an ELA and SS at the 30 level
 - Must register for 2 other 30 level courses (10 credits in total for grad)
 - Must have 7 courses to ensure graduation
 - Can not take a grade 10 course or INTRO in grade 12 year unless approved by admin
 - Minimum 35 credits planned in grade 12 year
 - 100 needed for graduation

- What if I plan on going to summer school?
- Should I register for this course still in PS?
 - Talk to your parents about your summer plans, summer school is very intense and fast paced, so it is really designed for those repeating a class NOT taking a course for the first time. If you are really set on taking this class, please connect with your counsellor regarding registration after spring break

- What mark do I need to go on to the next course?
 - You must have atleast a 50% or earned all your credits in your option course to proceed to the next level.
 - Teachers make recommendations on your report cards for your success, so trust the professionals. They have worked with you and know your learning style and work ethic.
 - If I failed 3/5 modules in Fab Intro, can I take it again?
 No, we have 800+ grade 10 students registered next year.
